What to Expect

This is why Mrs. Reece offers test and quiz corrections on ALL tests/quizzes. Student will be able to fix their mistakes on a new piece of paper and receive half the points back that they missed. It is crucial that students take advantage of this optional opportunity with assessments being 70% of their grade.

Parents – you will always know if your child took advantage of the test or quiz corrections if their grade for that assessment ends in a .1 for example a grade ending in 90.1%, means a student actually received an 80% but made corrections.

Homework will be assigned Monday –Thursday with the exception of test and quiz days
